

# AFRICAN MISSION

African Mission is presently supporting the following projects:



**Dr Ray Towey** left his post as a Consultant Anaesthetist in Guys Hospital London to work in Africa and for the last 24 years has dedicated his life to the improvement of health care for the poor in Africa. African Mission supports Dr Towey's work by purchasing medical equipment, drugs and training materials for St Mary's Hospital, Gulu, Uganda. We also pay for course fees to improve the nursing skills of some of the nurses.



**Fatima Mission** is a very large mission (900 sq kms in size) based in rural Zimbabwe. Approximately 90% of those living within its are poor subsistence farmers reliant on Maize, Chomolia (a green vegetable) and a few cows, goats or chickens as their only source of food. The mission is a Roman Catholic mission run by a RC Franciscan order, the Capuchin Fathers. It has 16 primary schools, 5 secondary schools, a bush boarding school and a project for disabled young people within its boundaries.



**The project for disabled young people** is a residential project offering education to blind /deaf or disabled young people. The young people live at the project during term time and attend a nearby school. The school is the only school in the province offering a specific education for the disabled. In addition to their academic education they also learn skills to help them live and prosper with their disabilities. Before coming to Fatima many of these young people led very isolated lives and were faced with a bleak future. Thanks to the education they are receiving and the fact that they are living in community with others, their confidence and ability to relate with others is growing. **£57** covers one month's education, accommodation & living costs fees for one child.

**We have begun to improve the life chances of some of the children living in this remote part of Zimbabwe and also the patients at St Mary's Hospital, Uganda. In order for us to continue to do so, we need your help.**
